Our Impact

Since the programme was created...

- In its first year (2019/20), we supported a total of
 10 students, and from the second year (2020/21), a total of
 14 per year.
- Despite the difficulties posed by the pandemic, our 2 first female students completed their nursing studies in May 2021 and 6 more students in May 2022. All of them were employed within 3 months of completion.
- In the current year 2022/23, 6 students have successfully completed their courses. 3 of them have already been employed after taking part in work placement programmes.





Our Goals

- that started in September 2022 and provides academic and emotional support to our students.
- 2) Expand the Programme to reach a higher number of students, therefore increasing our impact, empowering women towards independence and helping bridge India's gender gap.

What we need

In order to achieve our goals, in the academic year 2023/24 we need individual sponsors that are willing to cover the costs of university fees and transport to and from university of our 14 students.

The cost of each student per year is £500 or 600€.
